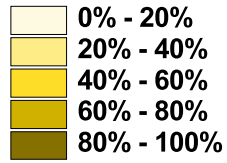


MTA Bus Depots & PA Bus Terminals In Communities of Color

The Percent of People of Color Out Of Each 1990 Census Tract's Total Population (*)

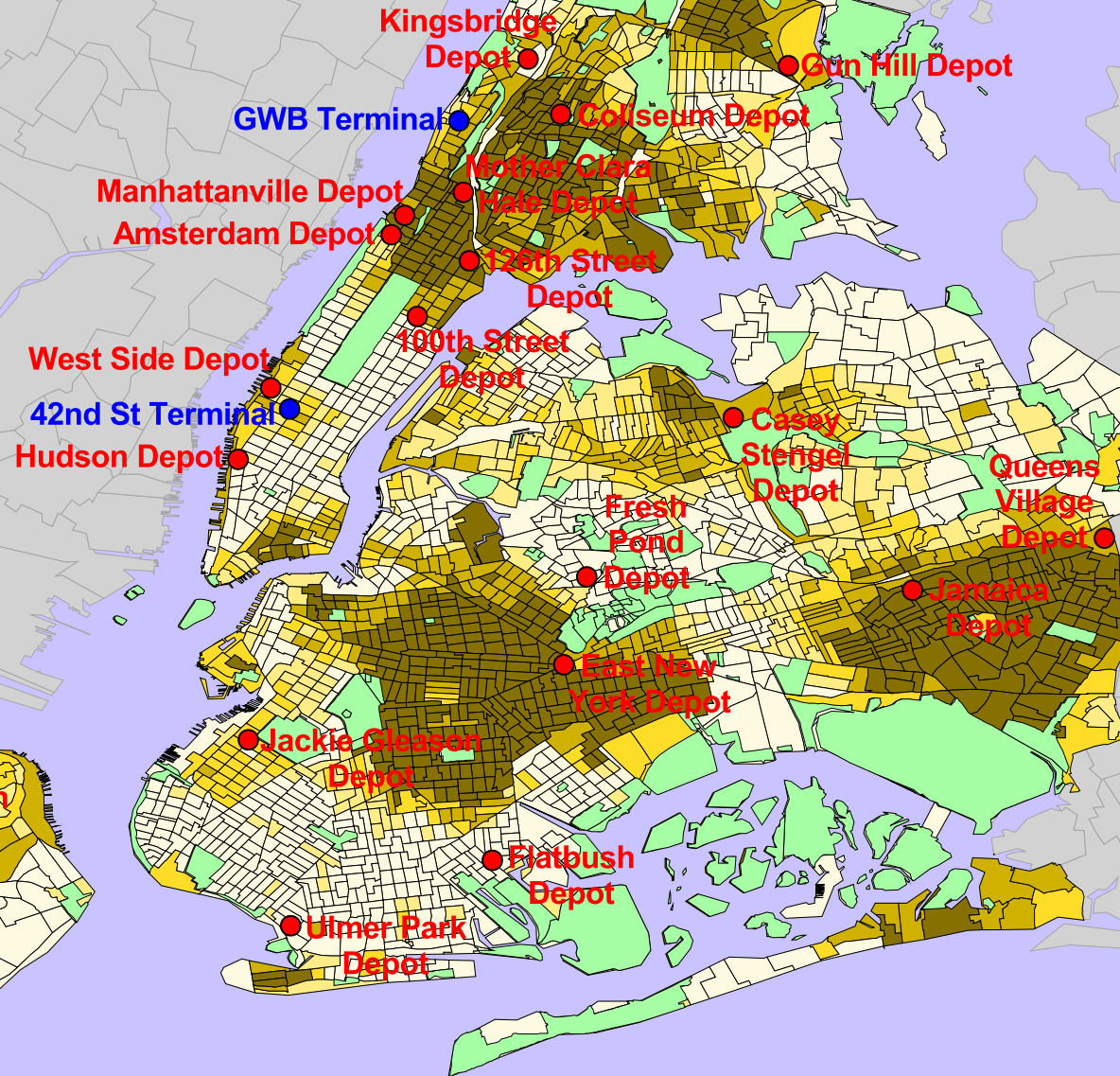

* "Communities of Color" and "People of Color" are terms used refer to all ethnicities classified in the 1990 U.S. Census forms (Black, American Indian, Asian, Other, and Hispanic) excluding White.

** A bus depot is an expanded version of a bus terminal. A depot contains maintenance equipment to repair and service fleets of vehicles that a terminal does not. A terminal is often just a way-point for passengers and a turn-around point for busses.
